

# National Blood Service (NHS B&T) Multiple projects.

The design for a new Production and Research facility for the National Blood Service (now NHS Blood and Transplant) in Bristol developed in to the preparation of a generic briefing package for an additional 3 projects.

The Bristol centre project involved a new production facility, as a self contained centre capable of expansion and with in-built flexibility to change as new tests and process are created, dealing with the delivery of blood, processing, testing and issue (PTI) of the Blood products, Laboratories for DDR, International Blood grouping reference library, Red Cell immunology, Vcjd, Stem cell services, and research and development and the associated administration centre including facilities management, IT and Training.

Part of the project required the upgrade and refurbishment of the existing Bristol centre to accommodate Bone Marrow matching, Tissue Testing, DDR, Blood typing, Donor Aphaeresis and other support functions.

Additional projects included a warehouse facility for the storage and distribution of blood boxes and the reorganisation of administration services to a new office building.
